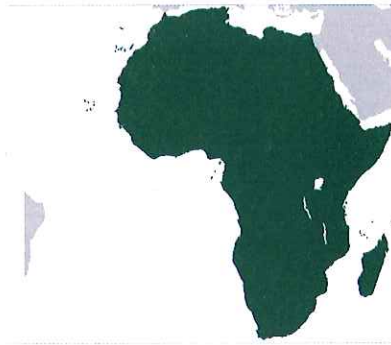
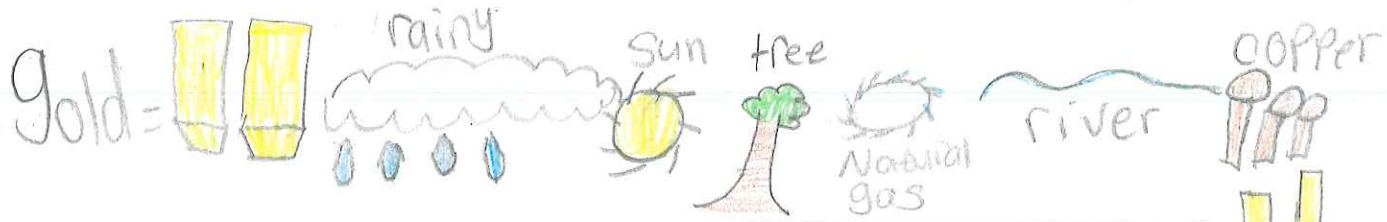

George Washington also had canals built along the river to connect the Washington DC area to the state Ohio. A canal is like an elevator that boats use to go up and down rocky or shallow parts of rivers.

Last, we started working on our final product which is a cookbook that also teaches people about the country where the recipe came from. We learned about many civilizations and for our final product, we each picked our own country to learn about. We learned that all civilizations or countries need elements of the hierarchy of survival to survive. All of these countries use their natural resources like food, the rivers, and trade to survive. 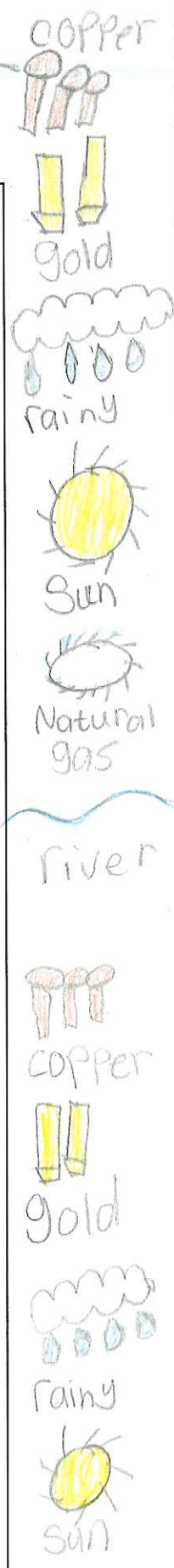
# Ethiopia

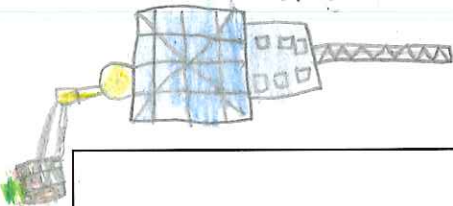
In Trinidad and Tobago

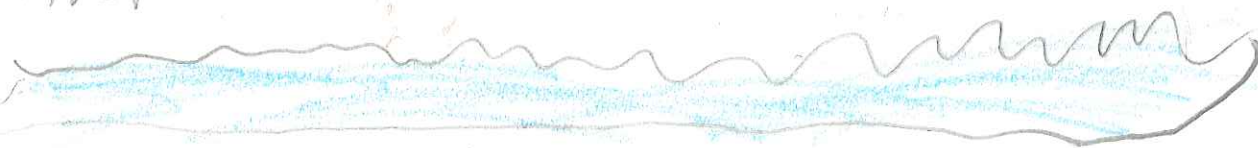


Italy

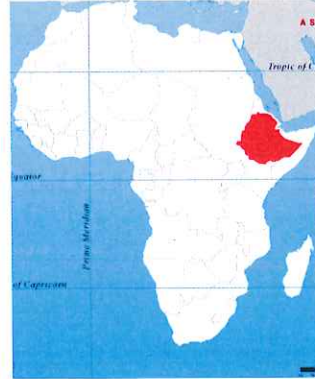

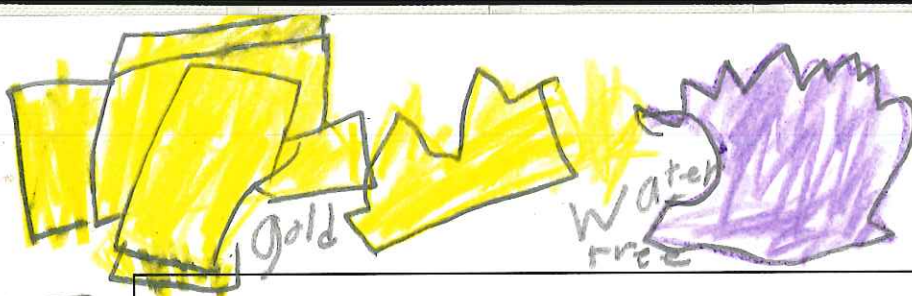

### El Salvador By Oliver Mateo

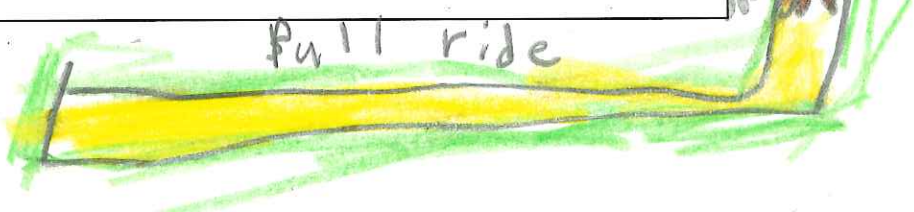
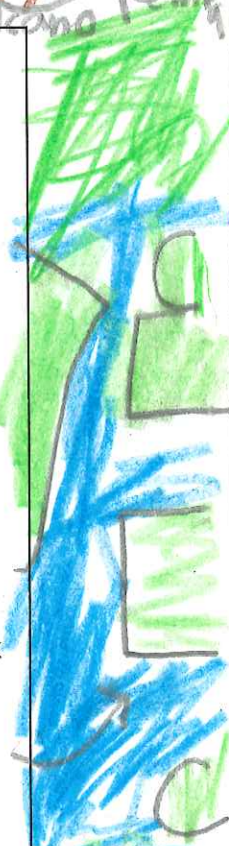

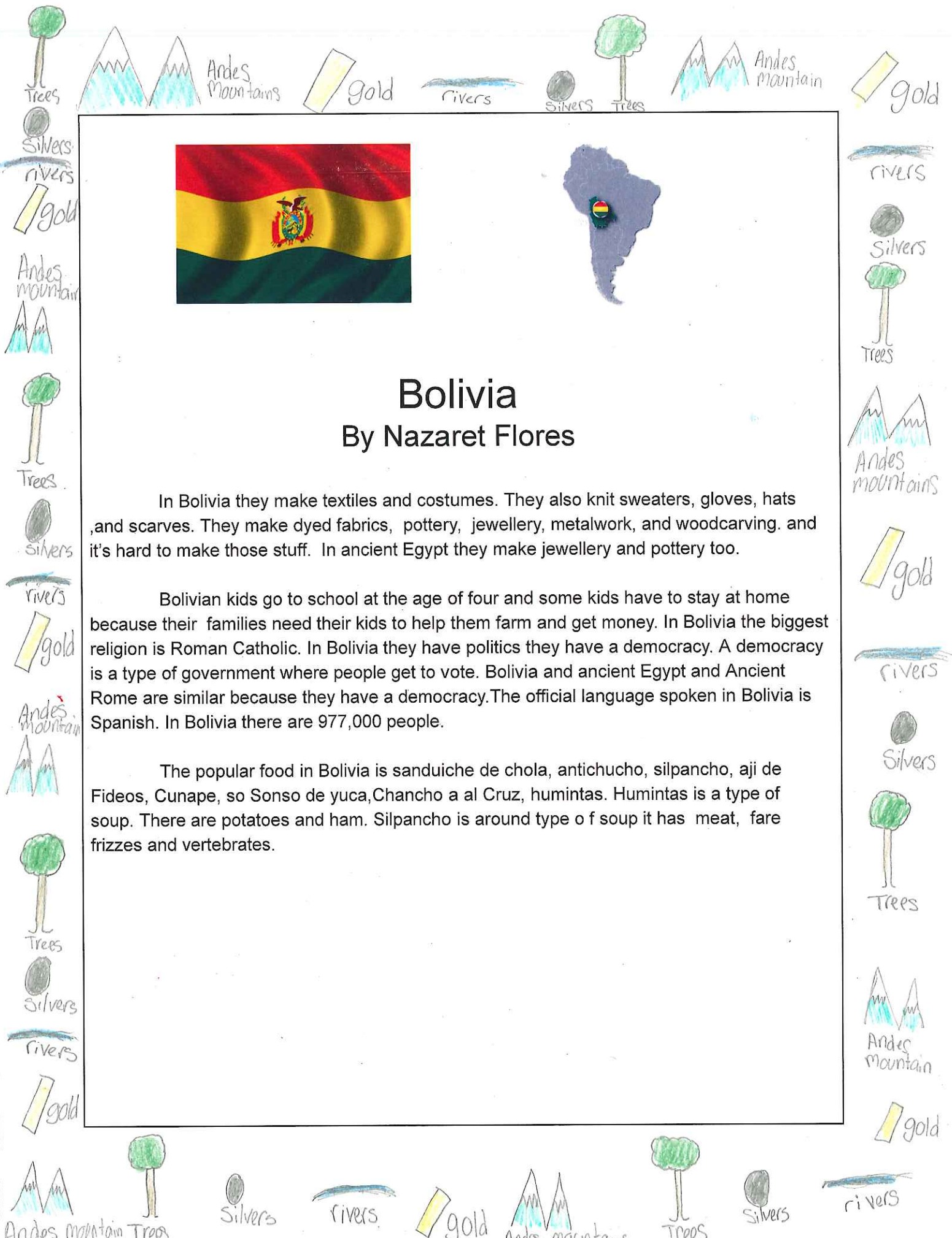
# Bolivia

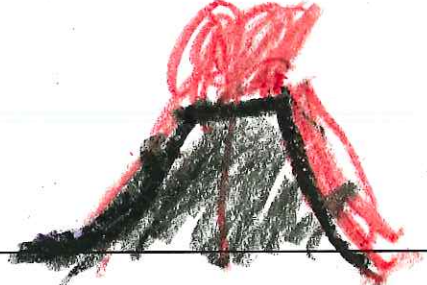

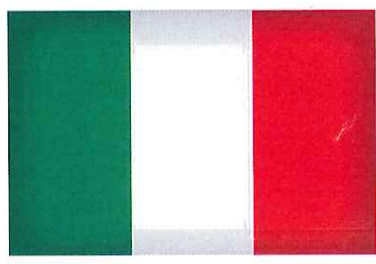

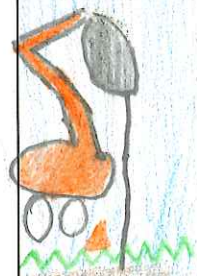

Orthodox teaching is similar to Roman Catholicism because they in their emphasis on celebrating Mass and honoring patron saints. Muslims make up a little more than a third of the population. A little less than half of the population belongs to the Ethiopian Orthodox Church.

In Ethiopia they eat genfo, fish. Food in Ethiopia is organic so we don't get sick or throw up or die. Ethiopians don't use chemicals in food. In Ethiopia when people eat, they eat together on a big plate. Genfo is a porridge with spices and butter. It is made with barley, wheat, or corn flour: Genfo is the Amharic name for a thick porridge eaten for breakfast in Ethiopia and Eritrea. The most common vegetables are potatoes, carrots, cabbage, spinach, and onions. Common fruits include oranges, bananas, mangoes, papaya, and lemons.

In Ethiopia they build homes out of mud and mortar. Some homes are made with mud and hay or brick or huts. Ancient Mali has huts but they didn't use bricks. So people in Ethiopia don't have homes and live on the streets. Ethiopia has really good homes and some are really famous homes, that are really expensive.

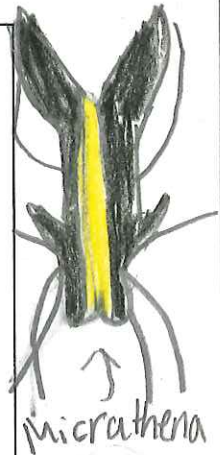
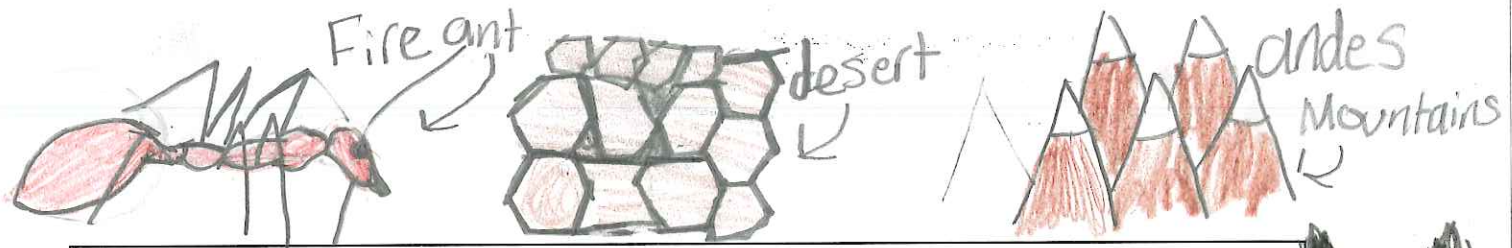
