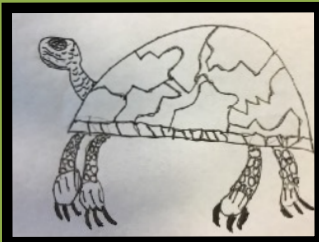


Some Animals You May See at Campbell School

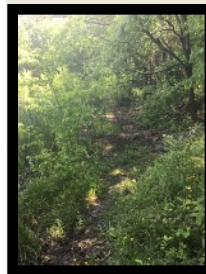


Visit Our Outdoor Classroom

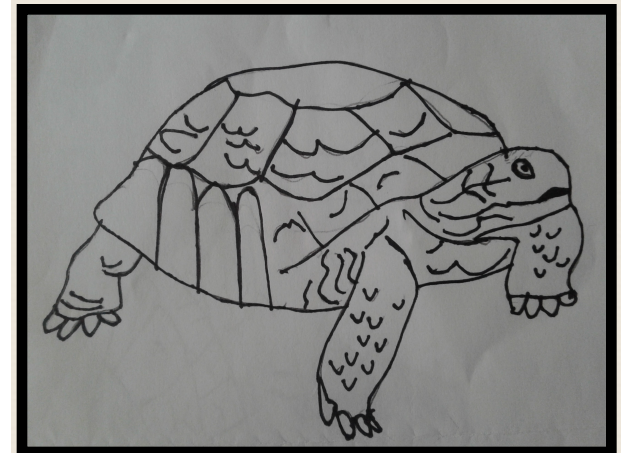

It has lots of trees and nuts and squirrel holes. They need these things because the nuts they eat, and the trees make homes for them. - Bazin



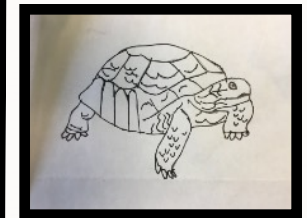
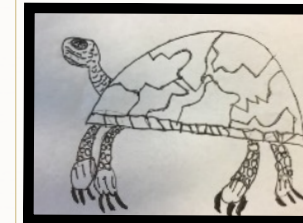
Grey Squirrel
