Dear Students and Parents,

This year, 5th grade students will have the opportunity to apply to be part of Campbell's Eco Team which will prepare a presentation for the SEAS (School Environmental Action Showcase). It is an event at George Mason University on April 23, 2019 sponsored by the organization, NoVA Outside. The small group of students will be responsible for creating a trifold board and collecting artifacts from Campbell to lay out on a table for students and community members to see and hear how we show concern for the environment at Campbell. Campbell students have participated in the past, but this is the first year we are sending out applications for students who are interested and feel they have lots of good information about how Campbell helps the environment. The group will meet to prepare their presentation mostly during school hours; however, there will be some work that will need to be done at home.

Students who are selected will need to be dropped off at GMU on the morning of Tuesday, April 23 at 9:00 a.m. and picked up at 2:30 p.m. by a parent. Students will spend part of the day standing at our display and presenting as experts on Campbell. The other part of the day will be spent seeing other student exhibits and learning from community groups presenting at tables about various environmental topics. As long as students report to GMU, they will not be counted as absent from school that day. They also will be representing Campbell and are expected to show exemplary behavior while at the event.

Parents must check all the boxes that apply, and students must fill out the application on the back. This form must be returned by Friday, February 1st. Students will be informed as to whether they were accepted on the team the following week.


Parent Checklist: Please check all that apply.
