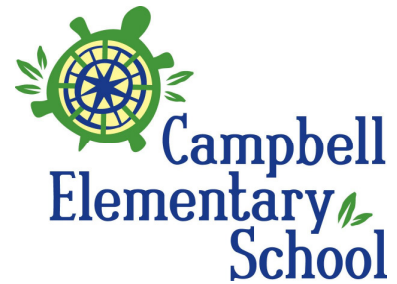

The Open House is an opportunity for your child to make a connection with teachers and students. Building excitement for school is important as your child gets ready for September. Parent questions can be addressed at Back to School Night, through newsletters and other parent communication. We are very aware that 5 hours of instruction per day is a lot more than was provided in the spring, especially for younger students. The first couple weeks in September will be focused on building community, teaching students how to use the technology and a gradual ramp up to a full instructional day. We also have plans in motion to provide students with materials to use at home that are non-digital.

Campbell Schedule

The schedule provided to families shows the daily progression of subjects each day. Each day, the teacher will welcome students and build community through morning meeting. Most days, this meeting will be live, or synchronous. Academic subjects and specials (art, music and PE) will be offered through a blend of synchronous and asynchronous instruction. For example, a teacher may show students how to do a math skill in a 10 minute synchronous mini-lesson and then students will practice that skill independently in a math composition notebook offline. Then the teacher might have the students take a picture of their written work and post it. Each day, the exact flow of the lessons will vary based on the content, just like it does in real life. The Canvas course will guide students through each step. In art class, the teacher might give directions, then have time for students to create work (on paper) and then upload it to Flipgrid. The teacher needs to be able to see that each student has mastered the skills.

Material Distribution

Campbell will hold a material distribution at the end of August to distribute Ipads, notebooks, and other supplies to students. More information about this drive-through event will be provided via Schooltalk messages.
